Summary:

The theme of TAMK (Tampere University of Applied Sciences) Conference 2022 was Sustainable Development. The conference invites every staff member to introduce their work and research and to share their expertise with others. This also enables others to learn from the topical research, projects, and pedagogy.

This one-day webinar in February 2022 gave a possibility to view how sustainable development (SD) is part of practices in all units of our university. At the same time this day facilitated building a feeling of community working for SD. TAMK staff prepared more than 30 presentations and a panel discussion on education for sustainability and future competences.
