AoC (Association of Colleges) sharing best practices with Colleges

Since winning the Beacon Award for EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT in 2022 when it was first launched in the sector, we have presented to multiple conferences and events at various levels to share best practice. Examples include:

- AoC Governance Professional Conference – A breakout session titled "Sustainability, the FE Journey & Strategy"

Torbay Climate Action Group

Significant engagement & input into a local authority/Businesses Partnership with our community via the Torbay Climate Change Action group. Contribution in writing, partnering & sharing their "Torbay Climate Emergency Plan". This included support/input with "Climate Conversation Events" in our area.

Torbay UNESCO Geopark Management Group

Torbay is a UNESCO Geopark & with this there are multiple opportunities to provide our learners with links to & understanding of our local area. As a College we sit on the Geopark Management Group. We now have such a strong relationship & so many more young people are learning & understanding about how special their local area is.

We have supported the Geopark Coordinator & Global Geopark Network Executive Board Member over the last couple of months as she worked through the preparation of the revalidation documents, and on the Geopark 10 Year Management Plan.

These activities focus specifically around goals 11 & 17. Areas identified for development at our last accord 12 months ago.
