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## Dosen Mengabdi IPB University

The Institute for Research and Community Service (LPPM) IPB organizes the Dosen Mengabdi program, an innovative community service activity by facilitating lecturers to villages surrounding the campus, within and outside Bogor to interact directly and present solutions for the community. These activities aim to develop and apply science and technology (science and technology) from academics to society's welfare. In 2020 the number of lecturers who carried out their service was 343 lecturers from various faculties and various scientific disciplines. The service has been carried out in 345 locations in multiple regions, including West Java, West Sulawesi, Central Java, East Java, North Sumatra, West Kalimantan, Makassar City, Palangkaraya, Aceh, East Kalimantan, Jaya Pura, and Papua. Dosen Mengabdi program supports the achievement of SDG 11 - Sustainable Cities and Communities, by seriously developing communities, conducting education, and achieving development targets towards a sustainable society.

### **BENEFITS**

It increased community knowledge, answer community problems, and continuously improve community welfare. For example, Dosen Mengabdi activities in Cihideung Udik Village were able to increase participants' knowledge by 92.88%, and as much as 98.25% of the material presented was material needed by the participants. The two indicators are included in the high category, which shows that the speaker's material can increase understanding and is under the potential and problems.

### **BARRIERS**

The barriers in implementing this activity were since the enactment of Work From Home (WFH) due to the partially closed down policy at the IPB University Campus. However, these barriers can be overcome through face-to-face online with the community by paying attention to the Covid-19 protocol.

### **CONCLUSIONS**

Dosen Mengabdi activities continue to be developed to various other untapped locations to transfer knowledge from lecturers to the community. We hope the lecturer can apply the knowledge transfer activity in real terms to improve the community's welfare. In addition, the actions of Dosen Mangabdi carried out by IPB University can provide more interest and skills to the community to accelerate independent, successful graduation and impact the community's economy.
