What is a car club?

- Member-based organisation
- Hire by the hour
- Self-service, 24/7
- Convenient locations
- Different models







Car clubs in Scotland

- 9,633 members
- 27 car clubs, covering 30 locations (20 LA's)
- St Andrews Uni, Robert Gordon Uni,







Car club vehicles in Scotland produce

*from tailpipe emission:

Scottish Car Club Fleet

342 vehicles

- 49% less CO₂ than average UK car (90% in 3 lowest emission bands)
- 22% of the fleet is electric
- Newer, safer; 89% are 5 or 5+ NCAP rating
- Choice of vehicles

Suitable journey types

- 1. Short-duration journeys
- 2. Longer approach journeys by train

Behavioural Change

After joining, Scottish members...

- reduce their average household mileage by 967 miles per year
- are more likely to walk or take the bus more often
- reduce their travel carbon footprint by 50%
