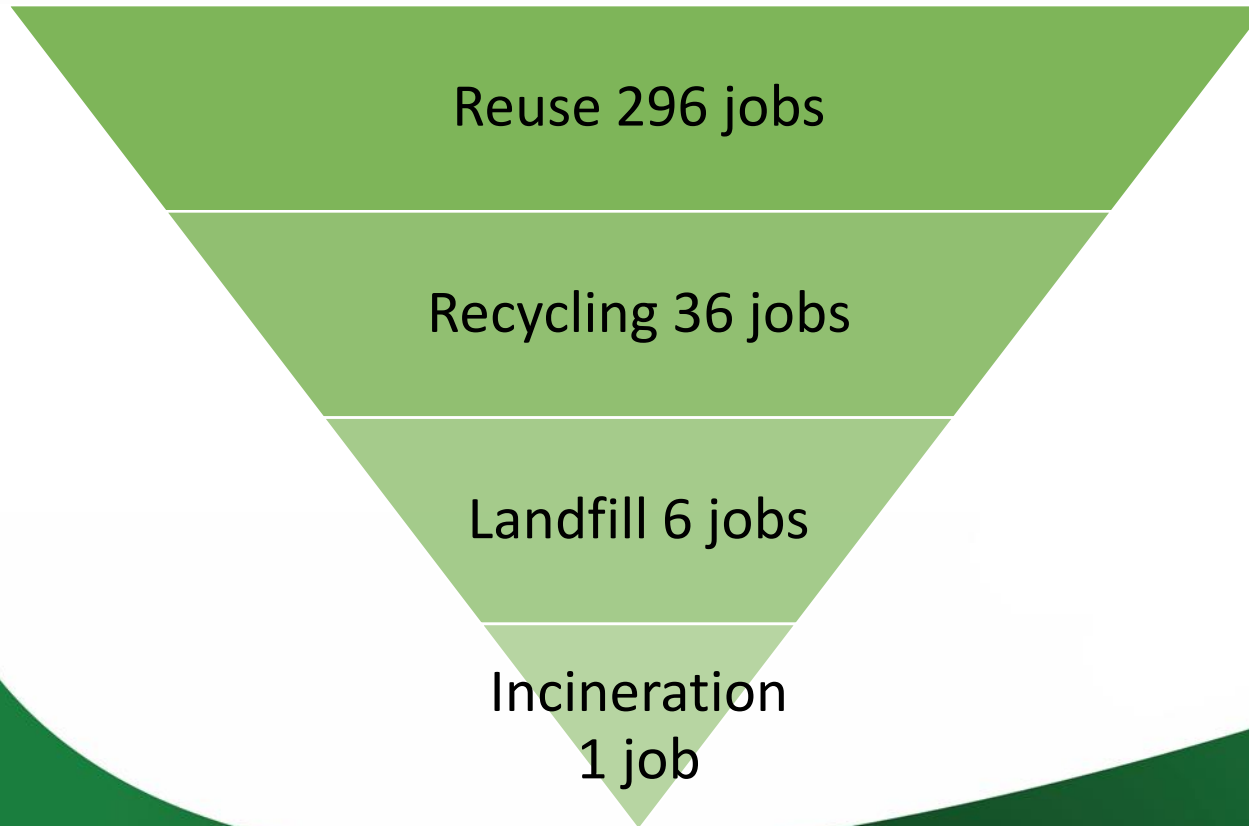
CRNS Reuse Lot Consortium

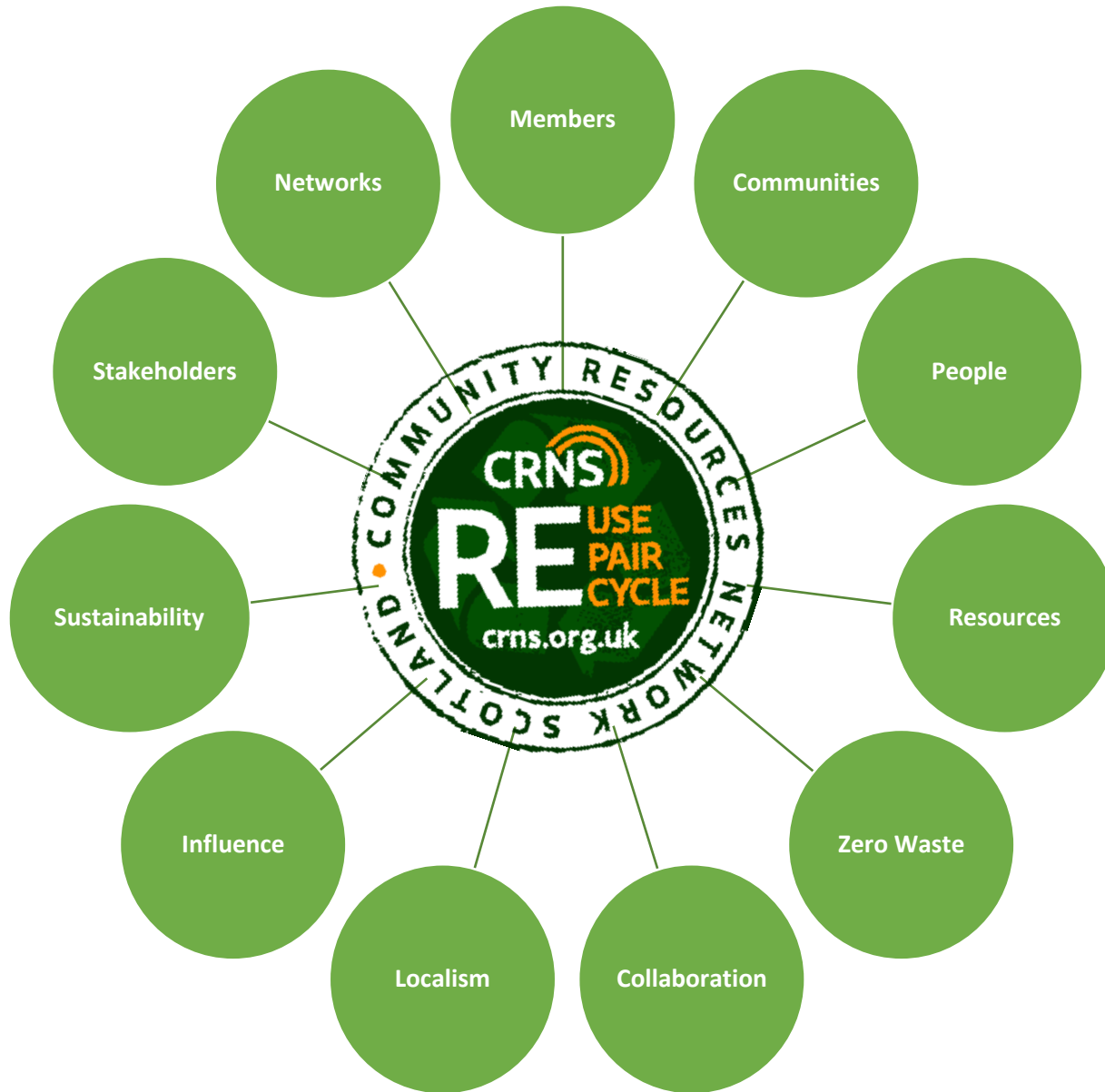
