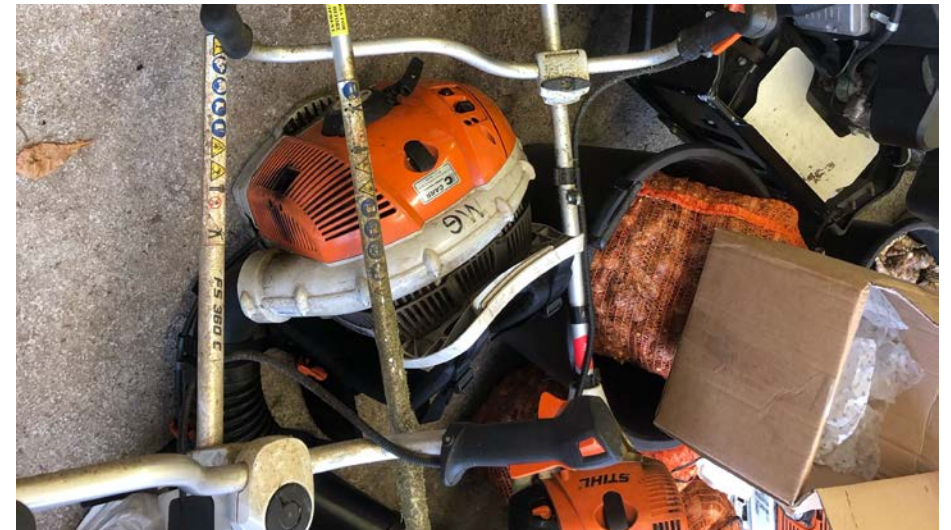

- Buy-in from Senior Management – budget allowance





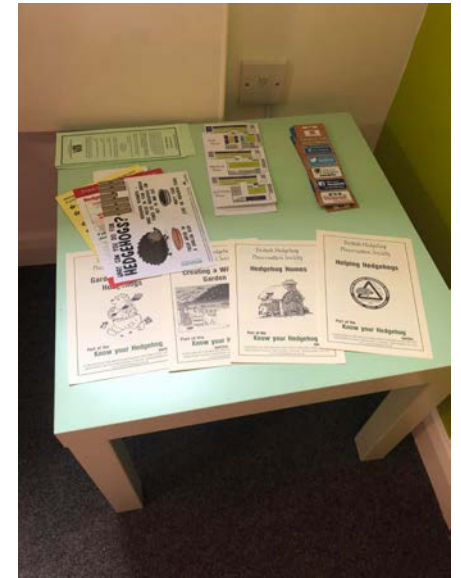
University of Sheffield

- Working with local NHS building and local council on signage and Hedgehog Highways



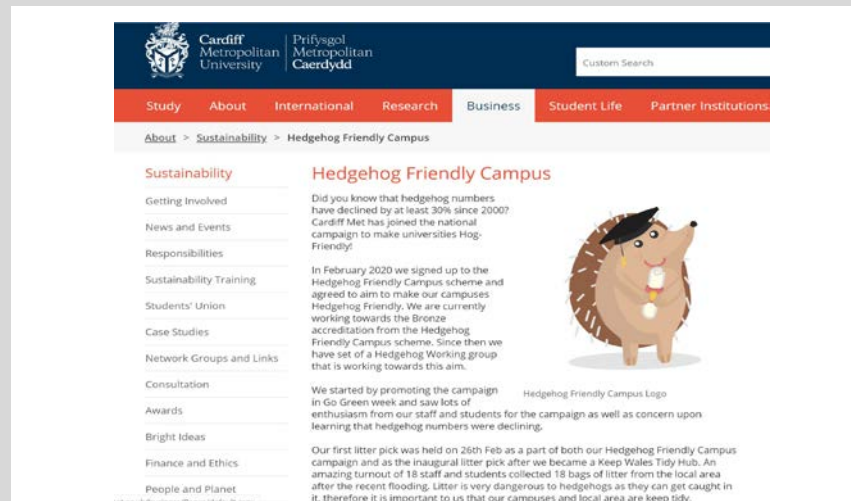
Case Study: The University of Birmingham
