Aims

- → Help changes to your parking management strategy to encourage more sustainable modes of travel.
- → Assist in the allocation of parking permits to make more efficient use of the parking spaces you have available.
- → Potentially provide evidence required to speak with local transport providers about improving accessibility to site.
- → Help establish whether incentivising particular modes of sustainable travel may be suitable, due to the potential uptake – e.g. rewards for active travel, dedicated car share bays, discounts for public transport etc.
- → Understand which staff could be targeted to try an alternative mode of travel depending on the most suitable option for them as an individual.
