## THE CHALLENGE

Keele University is taking a number of actions to embed environmental sustainability into the everyday life of its University community. As part of its commitment to sustainability Keele asked Lucideon, formerly known as CICS, to certify its Energy Management System (EnMS) to ISO 50001.
