## The project

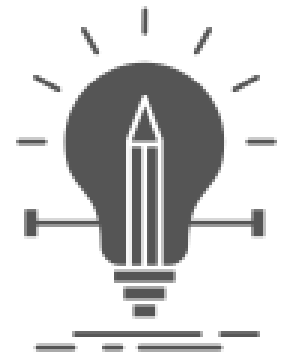
