What did you do?

Driven by its mission and vision, the <u>University of Baguio</u> is committed to *providing quality* and inclusive education to produce professionals who exemplify a higher standard of learning. With Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG 4) as its guiding tenet, the institution ensures that quality education remains accessible to learners from <u>all walks of life.</u> From <u>basic education</u> to <u>tertiary education</u>, the University of Baguio has been consistent in implementing programs

that cultivate the intellectual as well as social development of the learners. Through its initiatives in <u>scholarship</u> and <u>literacy programs</u> (<u>relevant skills for work</u>, employment, and <u>entrepreneurship</u>) led by various schools, <u>programs</u>, and offices of the institution, the University was able to produce competitive students and professionals. To this, both students and employees have excelled in <u>national competitions</u> and international conferences.

The University of Baguio also takes pride in producing <u>board passers</u> and topnotchers across board exams in medical allied (<u>nursing</u>, <u>dentistry</u>, <u>medical technology</u>, and <u>physical therapy</u>), <u>engineering</u>, and <u>accountancy</u>, <u>teacher</u>, and <u>criminology</u> courses. Consequently, the University of Baguio garnered first rank in the Student Support and Engagement Category of <u>WURI 2024</u>.

On the other hand, literacy programs of the university are not only confined to young learners but also accessible to adult learners. The University has also taken initiatives to implement programs and activities that address the needs of the former. Among these programs are the opening of the university libraries to the community on Saturdays, professional upskilling, and the implementation of training and seminars.

Another remarkable success of the University that serves as its fuel mechanism for continuous improvement, is its successful accreditation to ISO 21001:2018, making it the <u>first ISO-certified university</u> in Baguio City. To this, the university continues to ensure that its educational system maintains inclusivity, responsiveness, and future-ready.
