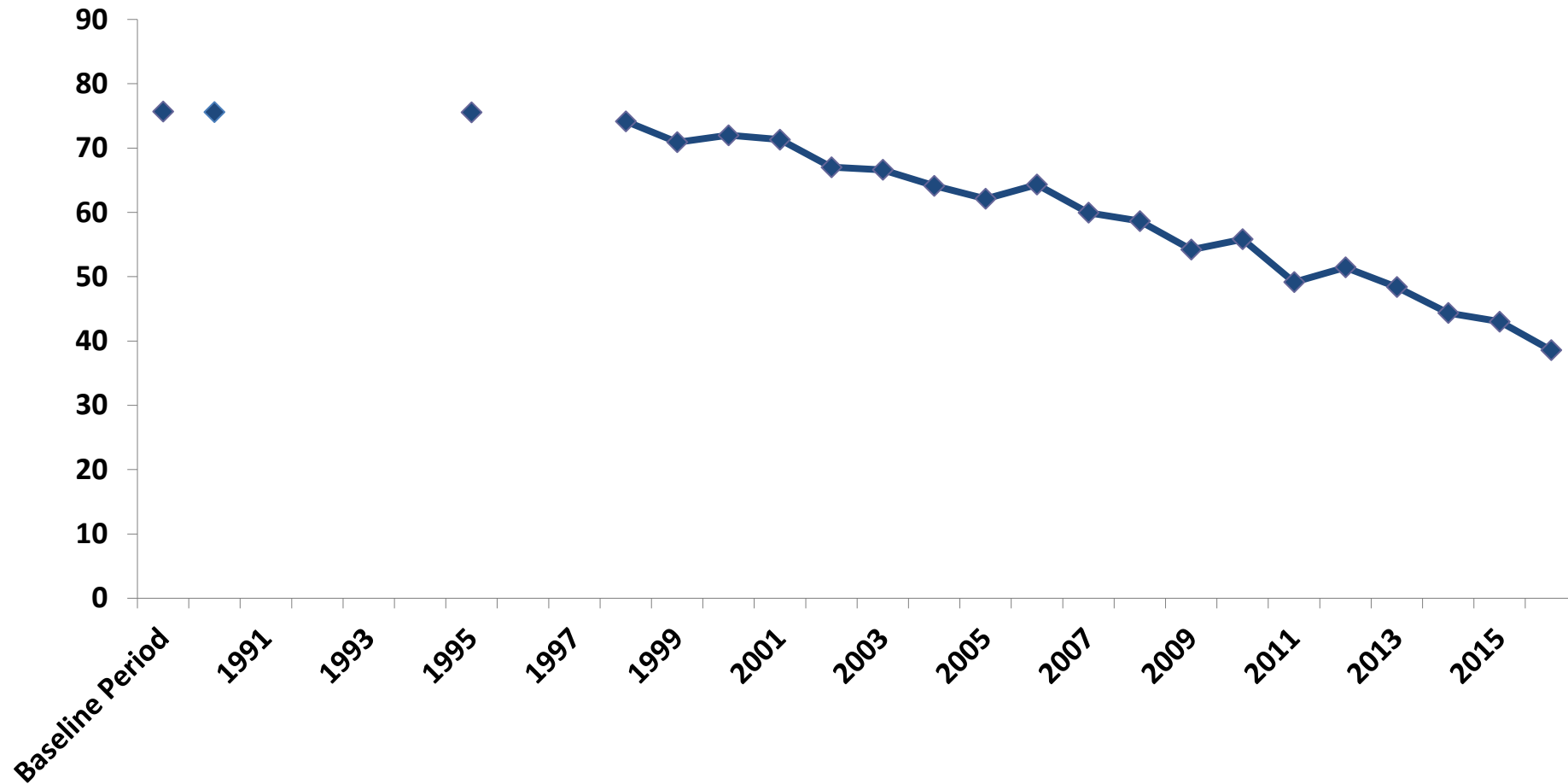

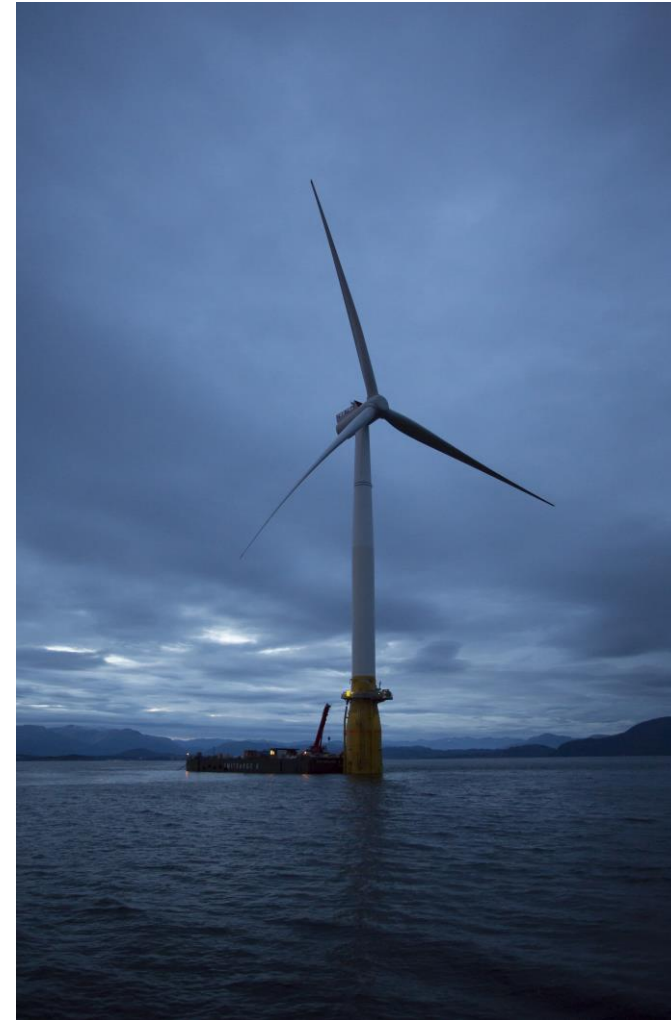
Scottish Greenhouse Gas Emissions, 1990 to 2016.

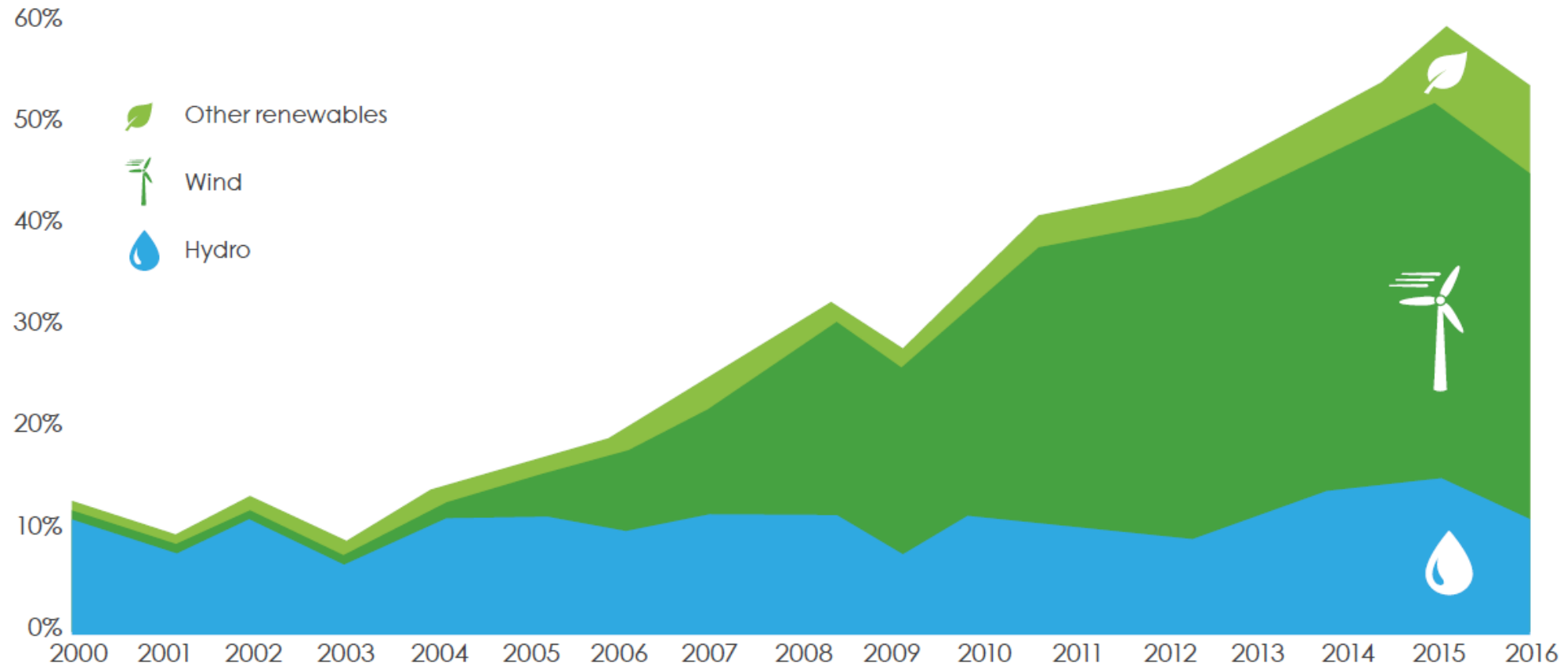

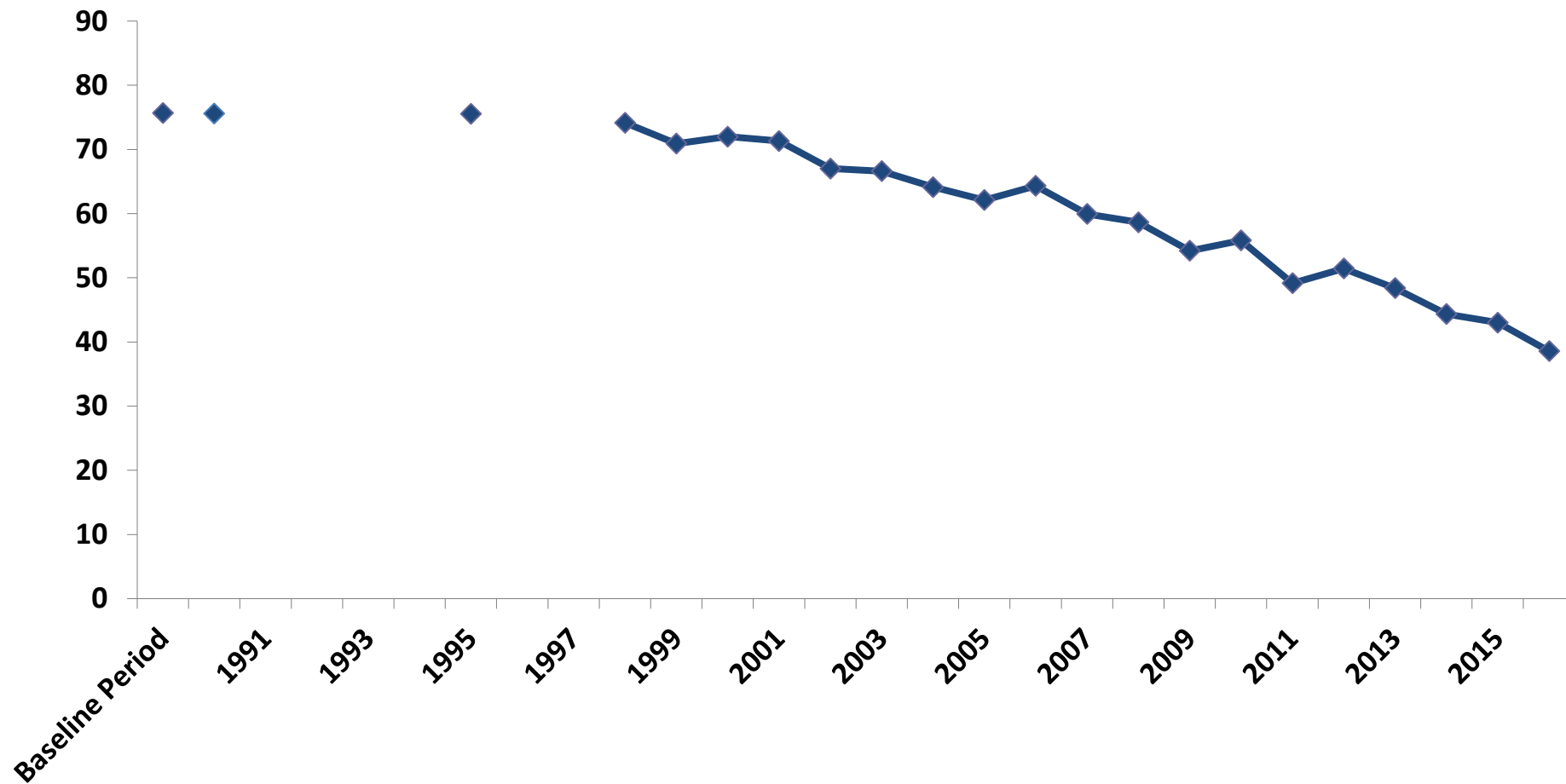

Values in MtCO₂e



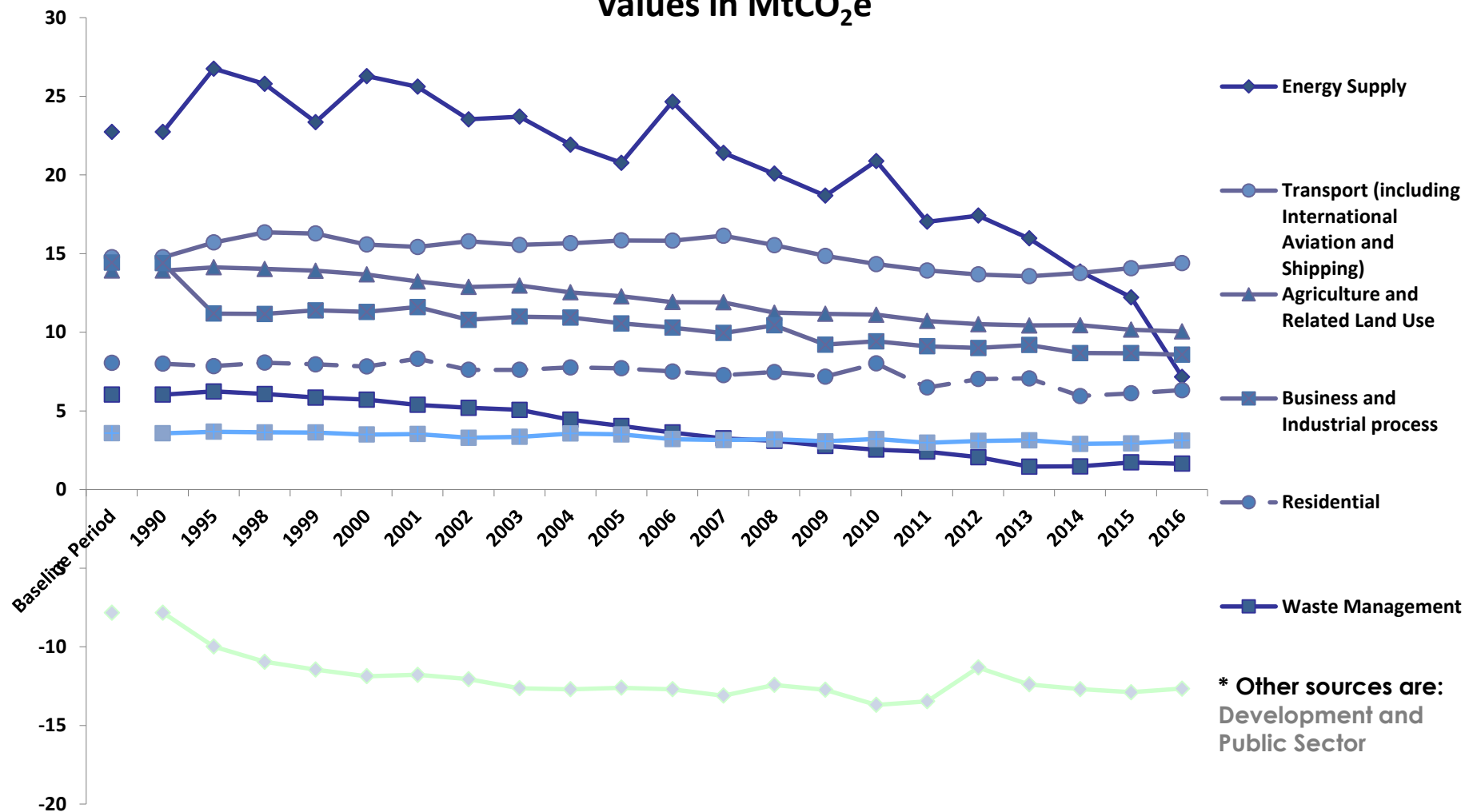

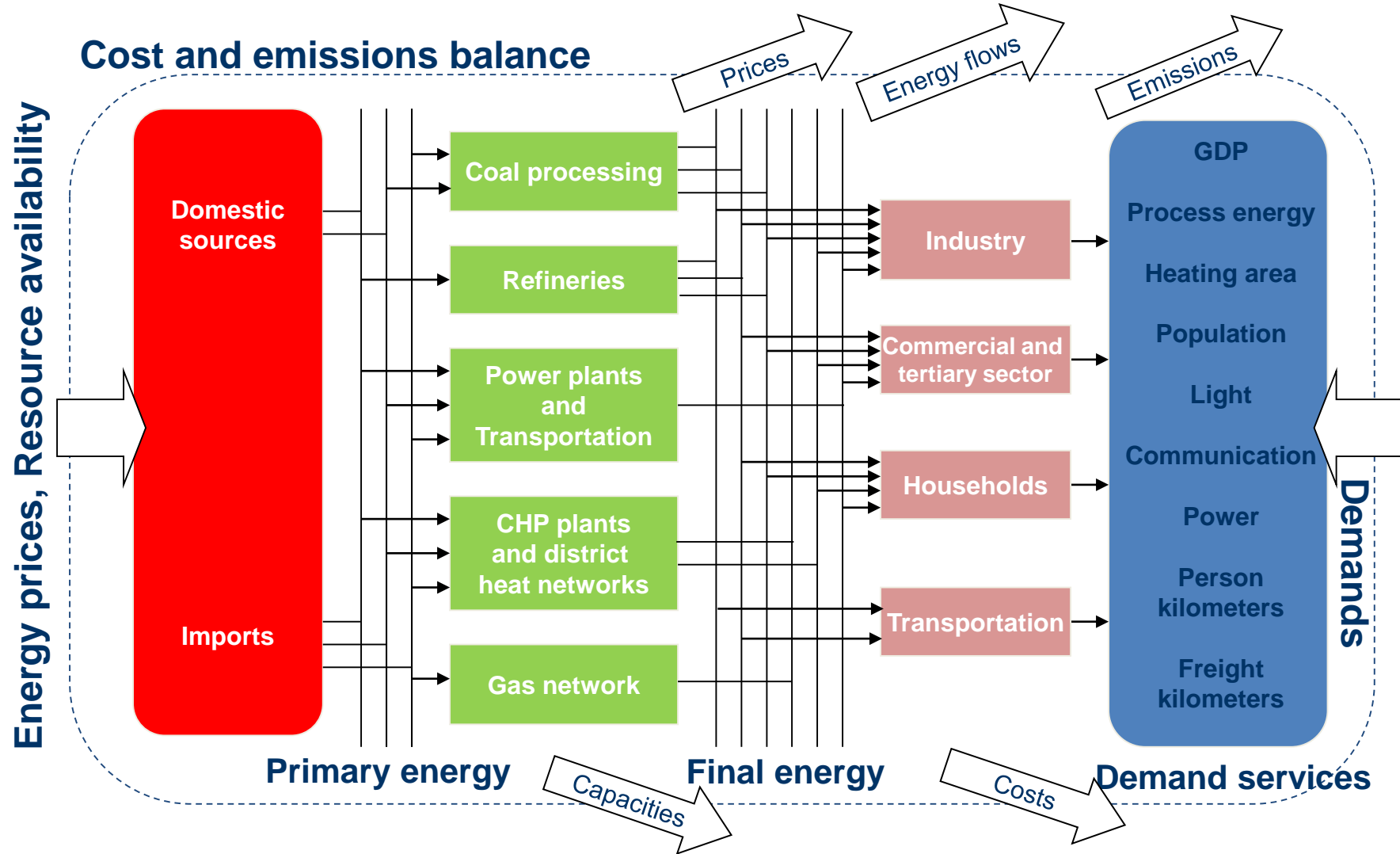

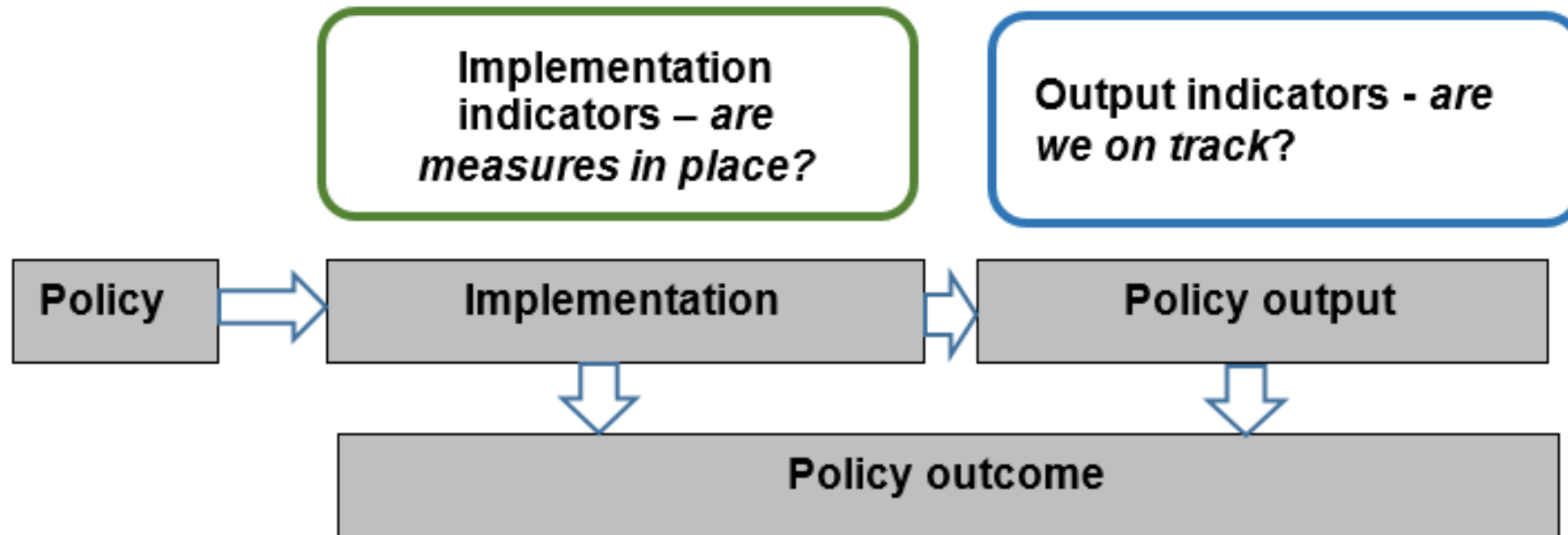
