Training Pathway for Lecturers

Abstract:

Providing a training pathway for lecturers which is aimed at the implementation of sustainable development in their classes. During 4 half days we go deeper into content and challenging teaching methods and we assist lecturers in implementing SD in their own subject/course.

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Description:

Because we find that lecturers as well struggle sometimes with the concept of sustainable development, we offer them a training pathway (voluntary). During four half days we want to provide them with some theory regarding SD (introduction, paradigms, systems thinking, etc.). In addition, we apply an innovative pedagogic methodology to put this theory into practice. Finally, we examine together with the lecturer how he/she can integrate sustainable development (even) more into the course.

To that end we use both internal and external experts. The members of the working group 'Sustainable Development' are responsible for assisting the lecturers in the implementation of SD in their course.

We aim at a maximum of 15 to 20 lecturers. However, we expect them to follow each of the 4 sessions (unless there is a case of force majeure, of course).

Naturally, we hope to achieve a multiplier effect, as a result of which SD will increasingly find its way to the curricula.
