SuLiTest Background

Sponsored and initiated by Kedge Business School

V1 Launched late 2013

Customised questions in: 17 countries, 8 languages

Engagement: 200 volunteers; 430 universities registered

Reach: 44,000 students in 48 countries

Average correct answers: 56%

10 corporate and academic partners and an IT partner UK Steering Group, open to all via EAUC PRME NUS

A catalyst for change





- •Knowledge-based Multiple Choice Questions on: Societal Challenges
 - Economic
 - Social
 - Environmental

Organisational responsibility

- Citizens
- Employees
- Random selection 50gs
 - 30 international
 - 20 regional
- •Takes on average 30 mins. Lets give them a go!
